








YOUR DONATION MATTERS:

SUPPLEMENTAL PROGRAMS FOR 2022-23X

Covid grant money was provided to our district and each elementary school site is able to utilize the support of the following positions for the next year:

- MTSS Liaison- Tiffany Goh (former teacher at Creekside) will be supporting our students and staff in our MTSS (Multi-Tiered Systems of Support) work. Our site will continue to look at ways to meet the needs of each individual student by looking at the whole child and addressing what their social emotional and academic needs are to be successful in school.
- Art Instructional Assistant- Bhu Singh will return to Creekside to teach our students art and to support our TK and Kindergarten classes in their Centers.
- Counselor-Our site will benefit from a counselor who will provide additional support for students either 1:1 or in small groups. Our counselor also helps lead students in board games during recess and leads our staff in many professional developments to focus on Social Emotional Wellness.
- Reading Interventionist-Title One-Creekside qualifies for Title One funds which will support a
 Reading Interventionist to work with students who require explicit and direct instruction on a
 consistent basis.

SUPPORT STAFF

Each grade level will have a support staff employee, either Paraeducator or an Instructional Assistant. They will coordinate with the teachers to work either in small groups of students or one-on-one. they support students with reteaching, reviewing, enhancing or excelling based on need.

READING INSTRUCTIONAL ASSISTANT

Ellen Nave will support our Reading Lab as Reading Instructional Assistant. She will provide assistance to children in reading instruction and reading intervention. These positions are critical to our MTSS (Multi Tiered Systems of Support) as we continue to implement our WIN Time (What I Need) program to continuously monitor students' academic growth in reading, writing and math.



LIBRARIAN

David Laufle, our Librarian, will support teachers and students with selecting books, conducting inventory, organizing book fairs, ordering new books and reading aloud to all classes every other week. Mr. Laufle looks forward to providing a welcoming space for all students who love to read books, play games and feel like Creekside is a home away from home.



VOCAL MUSIC TEACHER

Our Vocal Music Instructional teacher will lead all grades TK-5th every week to participate in general music instruction. Students in grades 3, 4, and 5 will be in a choir format. 
